About 20 miles south of Buffalo along Lake Erie are the Southtowns of Erie County, including the towns of **Brant, Collins, Concord, Eden, Evans and North Collins**, and the villages of **Angola, Farnham and North Collins**.

The area holds onto its heritage as an agricultural center for the Western New York region; Brant, Collins, Concord, Eden and North Collins have from 20 percent to 46 percent of their land dedicated to agriculture. More than 150 farms dot the five towns, representing one of New York State's most diverse concentrations of commodities including dairy, fruits and vegetables, forage crops, nursery and greenhouses, horses and other livestock.

The region's agricultural assets are enhanced by the broader tourism appeal of the Southtowns, a rural region rich with natural resources, parks and beaches, historic sites and small-town charm.

From the shores of Lake Erie – **Frank Lloyd Wright's Graycliff Estate, Sturgeon Point Marina and Evangola State Park** through the Farmlands of Brant, Farnham, North Collins and Collins, to the last metal **Kazoo Factory** in the United States in Eden and the vast country setting of ski country through Concord, adventure awaits around every corner!!

The Coalition is a 501(c) 3 non-profit organization.



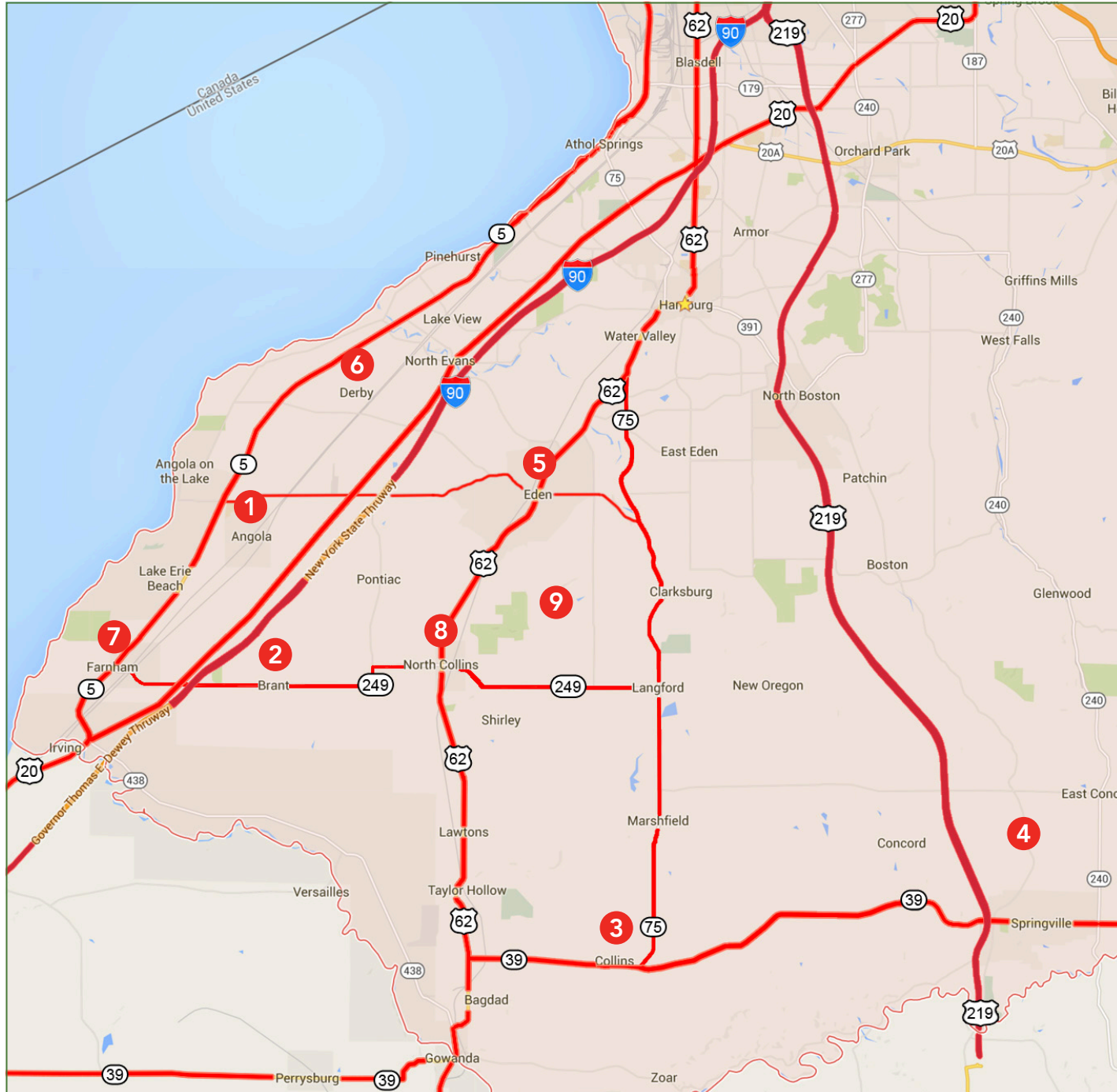

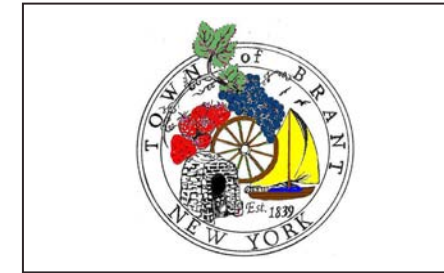
